### New Local Rule:

Golf's Governing bodies (The USGA, R & A and Golf Canada) introduced a Local Rule that eliminates the penalty when a ball at rest is accidentally moved on the putting green. The Local Rule has been adopted by all the major tours (PGA, European, LPGA, etc.) as well as the National and Provincial bodies beginning January 1, 2017. British Columbia Golf is also adopting this Local Rule for all of its provincial championships and encourages golf clubs and committees to include in their Local Rules.

Our Match Committee has reviewed the Local Rule and has adopted it effective immediately;

"Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1 are modified as follows:

- When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment.
- The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1.
- This Local Rule applies only when the player's ball or ball-marker lies on the putting green and any movement is accidental.

Note: If it is determined that a player's ball on the putting green was moved as a result of wind, water or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location. A ball-marker moved in such circumstances is replaced."

#### Did You Know?:

Part of our Pitt Meadows history that is not well known is that our course designers built the greens to slope away from the fairways. Art Botham and Jack Walters read a book on design that stated the golfer should not have a view of the green from the fairway. So that's what happened when the course was built in 1963. As well, the course did not have a sprinkler system until about 1981 so most approach shots had to be played to roll the ball up as the sloping greens did not hold the ball well.

One hole that presented lots of challenge was our 5th hole, which is now our 14th hole (we reversed the 9's a few years ago). A former men's club champ, Gerry Shook, had scores of 11 and 2 on consecutive days on the hole! Daye Roberts also score a 2 on that hole. Ask Daye about it.

Ultimately, our members decided to redesign all the greens to meet a more conventional standard. We rebuilt all 18 during a period of about 5 years in the early 1970's.

Some years ago long time member ANDY SMITH compiled a wonderful history of our club. In 2017, we plan to post a copy onto our website so interested parties can read it there.
